Code of Conduct Form

Participants (Players)

- 1) **CITIZENSHIP** - If a student athlete is in chronic trouble in school (3 violations) during the season, in trouble with the police department or bullying, the player can be suspended from the league. Suspension from the league will result in loss of Registration fees. Equipment deposits will be returned in full provided all instructions were followed in the Uniform Care sheet.
- 2) **STUDENT ATHLETE** – a player can be suspended from playing and practice time due to not completing and turning in their accountability form.
- 3) **MISSED & TARDINESS TO PRACTICE / GAME (unexcused)** - Two (2) missed unexcused practices/unexcused tardiness in a week will result in the player being held out of the next game.
 - (1) Unexcused tardiness in a week can result in a partial game suspension (coach’s discretion). Please communicate with your coach(s) so your son/daughter may be excused.

Once the coach blows the whistle to start practice or the player is given a time to be at the ball field before the start of a game and the player is not present he/she is tardy. Also, please make arrangements to have your son/daughter picked up within 20 minutes of the end of practice / game. If a player is not picked up within 20 minutes, that will count as 1 tardy. Again, please communicate with your coach(s).

Parents/Guardians and Activity/Event Attendees

We are expected as parents/guardians to conduct ourselves in a civil manner at all Fondy Junior Football activities & events. Failure to do so may result in expulsion of me and/or my family from the activity/event. As a parent/guardian and/or attendee at Fondy Junior Football events, I shall abide by the following:

- 1) I am not allowed to consume alcoholic beverages or use any tobacco products on the property where any game, practice or other event is being held. These activities are strictly forbidden at all school district facilities.
- 2) I will not use abusive or foul language or display any signs of aggressive and abusive behavior towards any team staff, teammates, other parents or league officials.
- 3) I will demonstrate a supportive and positive attitude for all players, coaches, opponents, administrators and officials.
